POSITION OBJECTIVES:

1. Responsible for officiating youth basketball games.

- 2. To provide a fun and safe environment.
- 3. To establish a positive relationship with everyone associated with the basketball program in particular coaches, participants and parents.
- 4. Responsible for the safety of participants at your program site.
- 5. Must demonstrate the ability to control all aspects of a basketball game.
- 6. May be required to work extended periods of time on his/her feet.
- 7. To work closely and cooperatively with other referees, scorekeepers and site coordinator.

DUTIES AND PROGRAM RESPONSIBILITIES:

- 1. Officiate youth basketball games according to general rules of the sport as well as any specific rules for each group.
- 2. Regular attendance and punctuality.
- 3. May be asked to assist scorekeeper with the clock, book or other assignments.
- 4. Notify site coordinator if supplies are needed, broken or missing.
- 5. Other duties as assigned.

QUALIFICATIONS: High School/College Student, minimum 15 years of age or older

TRAINING AND EXPERIENCE:

- 1. Strong background in basketball, some experience refereeing basketball preferred.
- 2. Some experience working with youth.
- 3. Some experience working with the public.
- 4. Must complete Sexual Harassment Training, as required by the Town.*
