## Town of Berlin Request for Proposals Kensington Road Bridge Design Consultant Bid # 2020-10

The Town of Berlin is seeking written proposals for a qualified bridge engineering firm to review the current Kensington Road Bridge condition, prepare a limited/focused structure-type study, complete a hydraulic analysis and other supporting studies for the selected replacement approach, and revise the Town's Local Transportation Capital Improvement Program (LOTCIP) application for submission to the Capitol Region Council of Government (CRCOG) and Connecticut Department of Transportation (DOT).

For a firm to be considered for this engagement, one (1) original and two (2) copies of sealed proposals must be received in the Engineering Office of the Berlin Town Hall, 240 Kensington Rd, Room 120, Berlin, CT 06037 by January 30, 2020 at 2:00pm. The Town will not accept submissions by e-mail or fax. The Town will reject proposals received after January 30, 2020 at 2:00pm.
